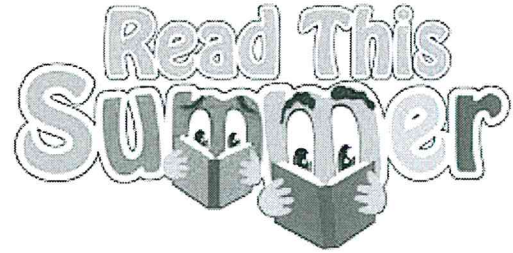


# St. Matthew's Middle School Summer Reading List
