

The Scouting Program:

Baden Powell, its founder, called Scouting “a game with a purpose.” The “purpose” of Scouting is to help youth fully realize their potential as they move into the future. The “game” of Scouting is comprised of the methods the Scouting program uses to guide its members. They include outdoor adventures, service projects, leadership training and experiences, advancement activities, and recognition of achievement.

10-Mile Hike at First Landing State Park

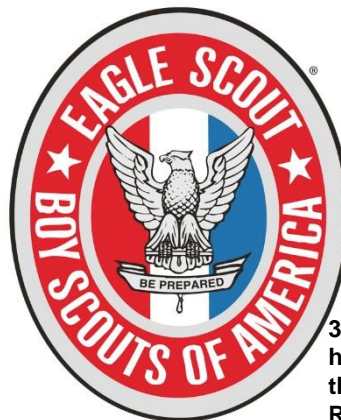
We welcome boys ages 11

A Typical Troop Meeting:

Scouts gather during the Pre-Opening when all the Scouts get ready for the meeting.

The Senior Patrol Leader leads an Opening Ceremony that typically includes a Flag Ceremony, the Scout Oath and the Scout Law.

Scouts in leadership positions present Skills Instruction, planned by the Patrol Leaders Council (PLC) to meet the advancement needs and/or interests of New Scouts, and refresh the memory of the Experienced Scouts.

The Patrols meet to plan activities, to prepare for upcoming camping trips, to receive information from the Patrol Leader regarding topics discussed at the last PLC meeting, and to give the Patrol Leader input to report at the next PLC meeting.

Scouts and adults gather for the Closing Ceremony that include announcements and the Scoutmaster's Minute.
